

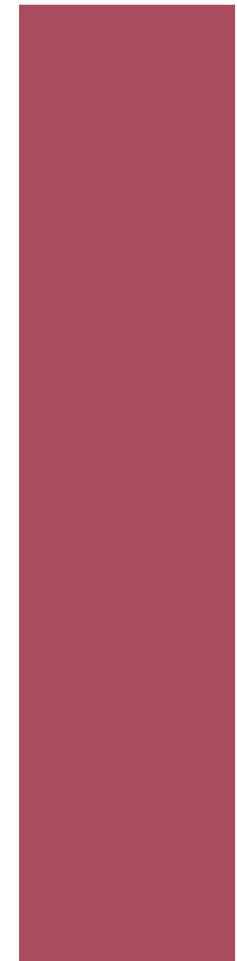


Our wine list is compiled, supplied and reviewed by Rory Stapleton of The Jolly Vintner.

## The Fizzes

### **Champagne Gremillet NV 12% £30.00**

This champagne shows fine mousse in the glass and fresh floral aromas mixed with characteristic toasty yeast overtones, which are balanced by richer fruit and classic baked biscuit flavours with a crisp citrus finish. Winner of IWSC trophy for Best Non Vintage Champagne.

### **Taltami T Series NV Australia 12.5% £20.00**

Straw gold with green tinges, a fine mousse and bubbles. On the nose, a clean and refined bouquet of fresh, floral, melon characters balanced by zesty lemon. Very fresh & inviting with red berry aromas.

### **Yearlestone Vintage Brut 2006 Devon 12% £18.95**

Oz Clarke called Yearlestone's first Fizz, toasty & biscuity with all the hallmarks of a top champagne. Made from Seyval Blanc & Pinot Noir, it is a local example of why English Sparkling Wine has been stunning the critics lately.

## Sherries

### **Desoto Amontillado - 50ml £3.50**

A classic medium dry sherry with nutty overtones.

### **Colosía Fino - 50ml £3.50**

Pale gold in colour with a delicate almond aroma dry and light on the pallet, it is a perfect aperitif sherry.

### **Manzanilla Las Medallas - 50ml £3.50**

A generous but crisp wine pale green/gold in colour it displays great refinement with a sharp, very crisp fresh and slight aroma reminiscence of apple blossom.

## Whisky

### **Benromach – Speyside - 25ml £5.00**

Citrus with a hint of honey and pine resin. Peaty and malt notes in the background. Smoky with cereal and malt flavours. Dries up with spicy/peppery notes followed by a delicate floral edge.

### **Bunnahabin – Islay - 25ml £5.00**

Roasted malt with a slight sweetness. Hints of tobacco and leather with an underlying fruitiness.

### **Rosebank – Lowland - 25ml £5.00**

Pale straw. Citrus notes with toasted cocoa aromas. Dry and spicy initially with cut grass and floral flavours developing. Dry cedar, pine wood, spicy flavours with a touch of ozone. Light.

### **Glenturret – Southern Highlands - 25ml £5.00**

Malty with fresh fruit aromas. Some herbal notes and a slight floral element. Sweet and spicy - dried grass, leafy.

### **Tullamore Dew – Ireland - 25ml £5.00**

Pale amber with an orange tinge. A mild blend of spicy, lemony and malty notes with charred wood undertones. Soft buttery and rounded.

### **Old Pulteney - 25ml £5.00**

Hailing from Wick in Caithness as far North as you can go. Delicious.

## Pudding Wines

### **Araldico Moscato Passito 2003 - 25ml £3.50**

Made from grapes left to dry on rush mats, this lovely balanced wine, pale gold in colour with a nose of fruit and honey is sweet but not cloying, perfect with lighter style puds.

### **Rutherglen Muscat Australia 25ml £3.50**

Delicious with a rich raisin flavour and a sweet finish.

### **Elysium - California 25ml £3.50**

Black Muscat dessert wine - Paradise in a bottle!

### **Domaine de Grange Neuve, Monbazillac 2007 France 25ml £3.50**

This wonderful blend of Semillon with a little Muscadelle & Sauvignon Blanc. Utterly luscious with a great backbone of fine acidity for a fresh finish.

## Ports

### **Krohn Ruby - 50ml £5.00**

From the smallest Port Estate on the Douro this delightful ruby port gives some of the more famous houses a run for their money.

### **Armagnac Calvados Cognac**

#### **Baron de Sigognac VSOP 25ml £5.00**

Yellow gold amber colour and clear. Complex and strong nose, giving floral notes with a characteristic perfume of plums.

#### **Maxime Trijol 25ml £5.00**

Produced from young cognacs, the Maxime Trijol V.S. is rich in intense, fruity, floral aromas, reminiscent of the flowering vines in June. Its pale straw yellow colour is the image of summer.

#### **Querville 25ml £5.00**

The apple brandy of Normandy. Excellent Calvados with ultra-smooth, concentrated apple & spice notes with a very long finish.

## Gins

### **Hendricks Gin - 25ml £5.00**

Hendricks is an iconoclastically produced small batch Gin distilled in Ayrshire. The unusual distillation process combined with the oddly delicious set of fusions yields a one of a kind Gin that is passionately loved by a tiny yet growing handful individuals all over the world.

### **Tanqueray No 10 - 25ml £4.50**

Is so smooth and flavourful that it can even be enjoyed chilled, neat! With its exquisite depth and character it will truly re-define the classic.

### **Tanqueray Export Strength 25ml £3.50**

Using a unique quadruple—distillation process and with sparkle and zest Tanqueray is recognised as one of the worlds best Gins.

### **Plymouth Gin - 25 ml £3.00**

Plymouth Gin is the only 18th Century Gin still batch distilled in the original distillery Black Friars in Plymouth. It is a unique style of Gin that differs from London Gins due to the use of a special blend containing sweet botanicals

### **Bombay Sapphire—25ml £3.50**

A clear, full-bodied London dry gin flavoured with juniper berries and other powerful herbs and spices

## Red Wines

### **Nieto Malbec 2006 Argentina 13.5% £15.95**

A deeply-coloured, powerful red with great concentration of berry fruit. Complex flavours of plums, figs, & dried fruit with a smokey vanilla character. Juicy fruit & great balance on the finish

### **Deakin Shiraz 2005 Australia 14% £15.95**

A rich full flavoured Shiraz, offering layers of ripe plums, raspberries and spice, in harmony with a delicate touch of oak.

### **Chateau Ile Patiras 2003 France 12.5% £18.95**

From a beautiful island in the middle of the Gironde, this delightful blend of Cabernet & Merlot is a classic example of an Englishman's favourite Claret

### **Marques De Murrieta Reserva Rioja 2002 14% Spain £23.95**

Benchmark Rioja which has spent a period of time in oak to give the wine roundness as well as the touch of class on the palate.

## Rosé Wines

### **Yearlstone No 3 Rosé Bickleigh Devon £15.95**

Dry fruity Rosé from Pinot Noir grape. Allow to breath and taste strawberries and cream. Excellent with salmon.

### **Pure Pink Rose NV France 13% £18.95**

The winemaker produced a refreshing wine with ripe, well-balanced fruit, ensuring the absence of that cloying residual sugar so often seen in wine at this level. The result is a visually stunning wine, produced from a blend of Cabernet, Tannat & Pinenc, that over-delivers in quality.

## White Wines

### **Deakin Chardonnay 2006 14% Australia £15.95**

A beautifully balanced fruit driven Chardonnay. Fruit flavours burst through with just a hint of oak to make a totally complete wine.

### **Muscadet Sur Lie 2007 12% France £18.95**

A beautifully crafted wine from the Loire. This Muscadet simply bursts with flavour. Elegant and crisp, this really is summer in a bottle.

### **Fairfield Sauvignon Blanc 2007 New Zealand 12% £19.95**

This luscious Sauvignon Blanc combines intense white peach and nectarine aromas with beautiful fresh fruit to provide a full palate & lingering finish.

### **Macon Lugny 2007 13% France £19.95**

One of the most widely available white burgundies from selected villages in the Cote Maconnaise. Fresh, lemony style with no oak-aging to mask the fruit.

### **Yearlstone No 2 Bickleigh Devon £15.95**

Easy drinking medium dry white wine ideal on its own or with nibbles

### **Yearlstone No 5 Bickleigh Devon £15.95**

Spicy & tropical, England's answer to Gewürztraminer
